## GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL COMMITTEE

### Objectives

- To develop a responsive and accountable attitude among all the stakeholders of the institute in order to maintain a harmonious educational atmosphere
- To formulate the policy to investigate and review complaints or grievances of students and faculties.
- To investigate the cause of grievances.
- To ensure effectual solution depending upon the gravity of the situation
- The Committee deals with Grievances received in writing from the students about any of the following matters:
  - Academic Matters: Related to timely issue of duplicate Mark-sheets, Transfer Certificates, Conduct Certificates or other examination related matters.
  - Financial Matters: Related to dues and payments for various items from library, hostels etc,
  - Other Matters: Related to certain misgivings, about conditions of sanitation, preparation of food, availability of transport etc.,

### Standard Operating Procedure for Handling Grievances / Complaints

1. The availability of Grievance redressal mechanism shall be widely published so that all stake holders may well aware of the same.
2. Suggestion / complaint Box have been installed in front of the Administrative Block in which the Students, who want to remain anonymous, put in writing their grievances and their suggestions for improving the Academics / Administration in the College.

3. Any complaints / grievances, the member from the department shall first receive the complaint and try to resolve the issue at the department level with the help of other concerned faculty and staff. He may also take the help of other concerned members in the Grievance Committee if necessary.
4. In case of complicated issues / grievances of serious nature he/she shall refer it to Grievance committee. The committee shall take the initiative resolve the issue by calling the meeting of all the members for deliberation.
5. If required, a hearing with the complainant or clarification from the concerned may be taken.
6. The complainant shall be informed about the action taken by the committee.
7. If the complaint / grievance is found invalid, the complainant and the person against whom the complaint is made, will be informed accordingly and penal action may be taken.
8. The complaint in any case shall be resolved within a one month of its receipt.

## Anti – Ragging Cell

The Institution has a committee on anti-ragging since 2001. Considering the determination of the Central Government and the University Grants Commission to prohibit, prevent and eliminate the scourge of ragging of any type and the gravity of the issue, the Institution had constituted the formal Anti – ragging Cell comprising of the Anti-ragging Committee and the Anti –ragging Squad way back in 2009-10 in compliance with the UGC regulations on Curbing the menace of ragging in higher educational institutions, 2009 and the suggestive guidelines listed under Clauses 6.1, 6.2 and 6.3.

The Committee includes members (senior Professors, Associate/ Asst. Professors) representing all the Faculties with the Vice Chancellor as the Chairperson and Registrar as the Secretary. The committee meets often and when needed to discuss directives received from UGC and put them into action.

Committee and the Squad are reconstituted every two years. The anti- ragging squad ensures the implementation of the preventive measure and undertakes field visits to ensure ragging free campus.

### **Objectives**

- To take necessary measures to achieve the objectives of eliminating the menace ofragging within the Institution or outside
- To act on the defaulters who are found guilty of ragging and /or abetting ragging,actively or passively, or being part of a conspiracy to promote ragging

## **Objectives of Anti Ragging Committee**

Anti-Ragging Committee will be the Supervisory and Advisory Committee on matters of Planning Action for Building and Preserving a Culture of Ragging Free Environment in the University Campus.

The Anti-Ragging Squad will work under the Supervision of Anti Ragging Committee and to engage in the works of checking places like Hostels, Buses, Canteens, Classrooms and other places of student congregation, for any incidences of Ragging, and shall educate the students at large in the University about Menace of Ragging and related Punishment Provisions. Anti-Ragging Committee will be involved in designing strategies and action plan for curbing the Menace of Ragging in the University by adopting array of activities.

## **Objectives of Anti Ragging Squad**

Anti-Ragging Squad will be working under the Monitoring of Anti Ragging Committee and will seek advice from the Anti-Ragging Committee.

The Functions of Anti Ragging Squad will be to keep a vigil and stop the incidences of Ragging, if any, happening /reported in the places of Student aggregation including, Classrooms, Canteens, Buses, Grounds, Hostels etc. The Squad will also educate the students at large by adopting various means about the Menace of Ragging and related Punishments thereto. A gamut of positive reinforcement activities will have to be adopted by Anti- Ragging Squad for orienting students and molding their personality for a better cause. They shall work in Consonance and Guidance of Anti Ragging Committee.














Proceedings of the Anti-Ragging Committee meeting:-
